Applications for membership shall be in writing on forms furnished by the association Executive Vice President, and shall be passed upon by majority vote of the Board of Directors. If such application should be rejected, the applicant may submit his/her application at the next annual meeting of the association, when such application shall be approved or rejected by majority of the membership present and voting. Rejected memberships are subject to an appeals procedure and a hearing.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the International Junior Brangus Breeders Association (IJBBA) is available to youth under 21 years of age who own registered Brangus cattle or have an interest in Brangus. Annual dues are \$25.00 each year. Membership in the organization benefits you in several ways. It allows you to participate in all junior activities, apply for available scholarships, participate in the Herd Improvement Program, and receive three junior newsletters throughout the year.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Active membership is \$125.00 each year with renewal notices mailed annually in November of each year. After December 31 membership will be \$145.00 for renewals. Dues for Junior Membership are \$25.00 with renewal notices mailed November of each year.

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

An Active member shall be a reputable breeder of Brangus cattle, of good character and must own registered cattle in the association. Individuals, partnership, corporation, co-ownership, syndicate or ownership by a trust or estate or heir of any deceased person holding membership in his lifetime may become active members. It is provided, however, that not more than five of such corporations can, or heirs of such deceased members shall be entitled to membership.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate membership shall be granted to any person of reputable character, interested in promotion of the best interests of the Brangus breed of cattle, but said associate memberships shall be without voting power or the right to register, certify or enroll cattle at member rates.
